The focus of Cornwall Rural Community Council's many years of work on Social Inclusion has been on carers, mental health issues, Black and Minority Ethnic groups, the development of a Poverty Forum and work with young people. However, there are many elements to Social Inclusion in today's rural communities and through the workshops and in particular through our 'marketplace', practitioners from different disciplines will have a rare chance to interact.

The conference is also a celebration. It is our 60th anniversary event. Cornwall Rural Community Council was launched as a charity in 1946 to help voluntary groups and support the cause of rural communities. This event gives us a chance to showcase a few examples of the best of recent work.

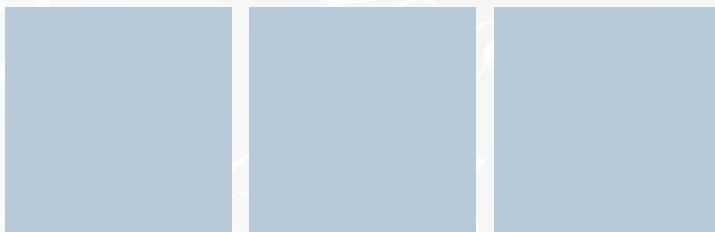
